TRADERS GO TO CITY HALL TO PRESS CASE ON TRANSPORT FOR LONDON FAILURES

Traders, along with some of their supporters, visited City Hall to meet local GLA member for Enfield & Haringey, Joanne McCartney, to press for a review of TfL's handling of investigations into the ongoing complaints of unacceptable conduct by the market operator and for a fresh investigation. Joanne was thanked for the support she has previously given traders, including having written to the Mayor on behalf of traders about the situation on a number of occasions. Traders will also now be writing to the Deputy Mayor with responsibility for regeneration, Jules Pipe, and the Deputy Mayor with responsibility for transport, Heidi Alexander.

Carlos Burgos, longstanding market campaigner said "We are not simply saying what we think about the behaviour of the market operator but that Transport for London can't simply undertake whitewash investigations when it comes to matters of ethics and community cohesion. Otherwise TfL is in danger of giving the impression that they condone racism and bullying. If that's the case then we have a right to know whether the elected officials they are ultimately accountable to agree with this 'turn a blind eye' approach".
